**Please note: If your child is enrolling in the Advance Class they must take one of the June classes!**

**Classes are held Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.**

(Students are expected to bring their own lunch and drink with them.)

**The Workshop is open to children between the ages of 10 and 17.**

**COST** is \$175 per child for the ENTIRE week of classes!

There is a discount for children from the same household.

Every additional child costs \$150 if they attend the same workshop.

**PLEASE BE ADVISED** that the class size is LIMITED; this way each child will be given individual attention and practice, and in addition we can better practice social distancing.

### **About our Instructor:**

Ellen Hutt has been an active member of Stage West since playing the role of Vernadette in *The Dixie Swim Club* in 2015. In addition to acting, Ellen has served as a props mistress, set designer, set builder, set decorator, stage hand, light designer, light technician, stage manager, production coordinator and director.

Prior to moving to Florida, Ellen was a middle school/high school teacher for twenty-three years where she taught social studies, English, and drama. She also ran the high school drama club and was an active member of the local community theater group: The Gratiot County Players.

With over 40 productions as director under her belt, 25 of which involved children between the ages of 8 and 18, she is well versed in acting technique and well qualified to share her wealth of information with young people.

### 2023 Summer Sessions

#### Monday

- Morning – **Introduction to Acting** →etiquette, stage set-up, body & vocal warmups  
**Introduction to Movement** →stage directions, body positions, stage crosses and turns
- Afternoon – **Motivation in Movement** →Necessary versus Interpretive, observation and concentration  
**Believable Action/Pantomime** →making your movement count

#### Tuesday

- Morning – **Finding Your Voice** →voice quality, controlled breathing, tone, and pitch  
**Can You Hear Me?** →volume, projecting without injury, enunciation, pronunciation, and speed
- Afternoon – **Characterization I** →how to figure out a character, interpreting one's lines, and interpreting one's movement

#### Wednesday

- Morning – **Intro to Music** →Selecting a song and interpreting music
- Afternoon – **Movement to Music** →how to move to the beat, basic moves

#### Thursday

- Morning – **Characterization II** → reaction to others, when and how to add emotion
- Afternoon – **Stage Make-Up** →understanding basic stage make-up application  
**Specialty Make-Up** →black eyes, scars, old age make-up

#### Friday

- Morning – **Special Movements** →how to handle those tricky moves on stage  
**Stage Combat** →making the fighting look real
- Afternoon – **Auditioning Techniques and Tips**→what to have prepared and how to impress

Please note that some sessions may need to be moved or switched, but all sessions will be covered during the week.
